

Early Bird Sports Expo 3-D Competition

Notice to All 3-D participants:

1. **Procedure:** Five (5) shooters will compete each hour from five different shooting positions. The positions may vary from a slight incline or decline platform, to an elevated platform no higher than six feet. After all shooters have shot all 4 arrows from each shooting station, scoring will take place. At **NO** time will the shooters be allowed from their shooting platform until the competition has been completed. Target distances will vary from 15 yards to approximately 45 yards. IBO regulations will be used as a guide for this competition. There will be a total of twenty (20) 3-D targets in this competition. At **NO** time will range finders be allowed before or during this competition. Anyone seen using such a device will be automatically disqualified.
2. **Scoring:** Each target has a high scoring ring and may vary from 12-8 points depending on the type of target used. If any arrow passes through the target, no score will be given unless the arrow can be pushed back through the back side of the target to determine entry point. If the shooter has an equipment malfunction at anytime during the competition a raise of the hand will let the announcer know that there is a problem on the line. However, the competition will continue and the shooter will be allowed to use a spare bow. If it's your turn to shoot and you miss your turn because of the malfunction, you will be given a miss and a no score.
3. **Ties:** Ties will be broken by counting the number of 12 scores, and then the number of 10 scores, etc... If at any time during the shoot off on Sunday there is a tie, Ties will be broken by a predetermined target that will be announced at that time.
4. **Time:** This event is timed using a light that will shine on your target when it is your turn to shoot. It is your responsibility to identify your target and shoot one (1) arrow within **seven seconds**. However, all shooters are permitted to nock, arrow and attach their release to the D-loop or string prior to their turn. At no time will a shooter be allowed to have his/her bow at full draw prior to their turn.
5. **Awards:** A detailed list of awards and methods of determining winners was sent with your application and score card. All awards will be given on Sunday the last day of the event to the top three (3) individuals of the three flights.
6. **Flights:** The flights will be determined on Saturday night after the qualification rounds have been completed. The number of each flight will not be determined until everyone has qualified. You will be notified on Saturday night by one of the officials via telephone as to what flight you are in and your shooting time. Anyone that cannot make it for Sunday's Championship round is asked to give immediate notice so an alternate can be called. Failure to show on Sunday for your designated shooting time will forfeit your right to continue in the Championship round.
7. **Release:** You will be required to sign a release prior to shooting that will relinquish the Early Bird Sports Expo of any legal action, from theft, injury etc... Refer to release form and read.
8. **Registration:** Registration cannot be transferred from one shooter to the next. Shooters maybe required producing some form of picture identification prior to your shooting time on Sunday's Championship round.
9. **Identifiable arrows:** Due to the large number of shooters and the possibility of ties, we are requesting that you have with you two (2) identifiable arrows. This can be done by placing initials somewhere on the fletching. This type of marking will not alter the flight of your arrow.
10. **Crossbows and Range Viewers:** Crossbows are not to be used on the range as it is set up strictly for the use of Compound and Traditional bows. Range Viewers are not to be used by a shooter, a member of the shooters family, a friend of the shooter or anyone sitting in the stands. When

you are caught using such items, you will be automatically disqualified, forfeiting the chance to shoot for the remainder of the Expo.
